Jesus lived as a human and knew grief. He came to comfort. Sketch what grief can look like on one side of your mirror and sketch what comfort can look like on the other side. Pray as a family for those that are grieving.

MAUNDY THURSDAY

Jesus came to share God's love with all. Maundy Thursday is the day we see Jesus specifically teach how to serve in love. Sketch different ways you have seen people serve others with love. Pray as a family to be loving servants, just as Jesus taught us to be.

Jesus died on Good Friday. Many people question why we call it Good Friday if Jesus died. Reflect on all the good that Jesus brought to this world. Sketch your favorite act of Jesus. Pray as a family about how we can understand Good Friday as something good.
